SACRED HEART OF JESUS AND IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

Friday, June 16 is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. There will be a Solemn Mass and Procession at 6 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola Cantorum will sing *Missa Quando lieta sperai* by Andrea Gabrieli; *Improperium expectavit* by Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina; *Tribulationes cordis mei* by Andrea Rota.

Saturday, June 17 is the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Closely linked with the Solemnity of Corpus Christi is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, celebrated on the Friday before the 3rd Sunday after Pentecost, and the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, now celebrated on the following day. Another opportunity to contemplate Christ's unmitigated loving-kindness toward a fallen humanity, the origin of the devotion to the Sacred Heart in its modern form is derived from a French Roman Catholic nun, St. Marguerite Marie Alacoque, who said she learned the devotion from Jesus during a mystical revelation.

MASS FOR OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP PRAYER GROUP

On **Wednesday, June 21**, there will be a Sung Mass at 5:15 PM at St. Catherine of Siena followed by a devotional Procession. This Mass is the annual Mass offered in honor of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, sponsored by the prayer group under her patronage at St. Catherine of Siena.

SUMMER DEVOTIONS SCHEDULE

The weekly Wednesday evening Holy Hour following the 6 PM Mass at St. Vincent Ferrer and the Thursday Health Care Ministry Holy Hour following the 5:15 PM Mass at St. Catherine of Siena will continue as usual through the summer.

After Corpus Christi Sunday, June 11, Sunday afternoon Eucharistic Adoration at St. Catherine of Siena will be suspended through the summer, resuming on September 17, the Sunday after the Feast of the Holy Cross.

MUSIC NOTES

Next weekend, we return to Sundays in Ordinary Time (with the Eleventh Sunday). *Missa Simplex*, an English language, chant style congregational Mass Ordinary will be introduced for these summer Sundays and sung Masses during the week. The Schola will sing music of the Venetian Renaissance. Adrian Willaert, a Franco-Flemish composer who studied in Paris with Jean Mouton, became a singer in the chapel of Cardinal Ippolito I d'Este in 1515 and later served Duke Alfonso of Ferrara. From 1527 until his death, he served as *maestro di cappella* of St. Mark's Basilica in Venice. His pupils, including Cipriano de Rore, Andrea Gabrieli, Costanzo Porta, and Gioseffo Zarlino, developed this Venetian style, which became one of the most distinct in music history. Giovanni Bassano was a key figure in the development of instrumental music in the Venetian school. He began playing in the instrumental ensemble of St. Mark's around 1576. In 1601 he succeeded Girolamo Dalla Casa as the ensemble's director, remaining at the post until his death. He collaborated with and promoted the music of the Basilica's other musicians, most notably Giovanni Gabrieli.

EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL



Participation and Holy Communion, Part I

With the feast of Corpus Christi this year, we hit the one year mark of the Eucharistic Revival. We have reflected on silence and its place within Mass. We have looked at a brief history of the idea of active participation in the liturgy and there seen that the most perfect form of active participation is the reception of Holy Communion. It seems providential to begin a series on the reception of Holy Communion, then, on this great feast day.

To understand the importance of receiving Communion, it would be helpful to say a few words about the Eucharist, which has its foundation in Jesus' words in the Gospels.

There are two important Biblical passages that are helpful to read together. First, there is the Bread of Life Discourse in John 6 where Jesus says, "I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh... Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him" (Jn 6:51, 53-56). Second, there are Jesus' words at the Last Supper: "Jesus took bread, and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, 'Take, eat; this is my body.' And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, 'Drink of it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the

forgiveness of sins'" (Mt 26:26-28).

The Eucharist is Jesus' very Body and Blood. Through priestly ordination, the priest is given the power, flowing out from the graces of the Resurrection and the graces given to the apostles (cf. Jn 20:19-23), to consecrate the Eucharist and transubstantiate ordinary bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood. Through the words that the priest says at Mass—the same words Jesus said at the Last Supper—Jesus acts through the priest to bring this about. Even though the Host and the Precious Blood still look like bread and wine, their underlying reality, their very substance, is changed into Jesus' Body and Blood. As St. Ambrose said, "You read concerning the making of the whole world: *He spoke and they were made, He commanded and they were created.* Shall not the word of Christ, which was able to make out of nothing that which was not, be able to change things which already are into what they were not? For it is not less to give a new nature to things than to change them" (*On the Mysteries*, chapter 9.53).

If Jesus' words are true and if they actually have effect on our altars at each and every Mass, then the Eucharist becomes the most beautiful means for entering into interior communion with God. We will spend the next couple of months unpacking this and how we might better prepare ourselves to enter into a holy communion with the living God.

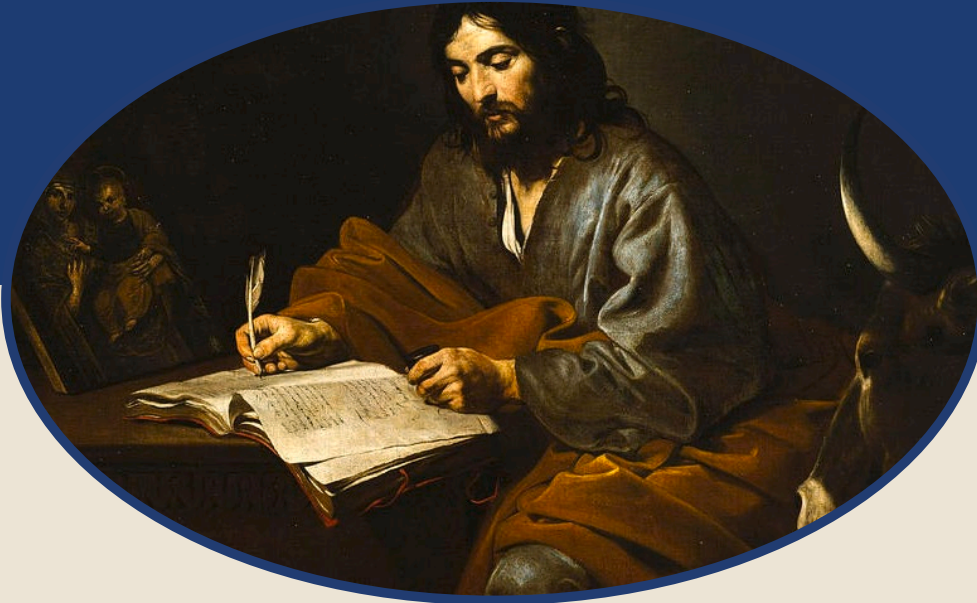

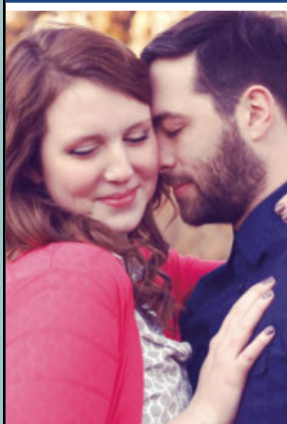

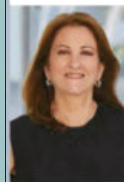
