EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION ON CHRIST THE KING

Sunday, November 20 is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, the final Sunday of the liturgical year. His Eminence, Raymond Cardinal Burke will celebrate the 12 NOON Solemn Mass at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola will sing Mozart's Missa Solemnis in C Major, K. 337, with orchestra.

Following the Mass, there will be a Eucharistic Procession down Fifth Avenue to St. Patrick's Cathedral, where Cardinal Dolan will offer the final Benediction. This is an official Archdiocesan event as part of the National Eucharistic Revival (eucharisticrevival.org). All are encouraged to attend.

THANKSGIVING NOVENA

From Thursday, November 17 through Thanksgiving Day on Thursday, November 25, the Parish will offer a Thanksgiving Novena of Prayer. Holy cards and petition slips will be available at both Churches.

FEAST OF ST. CECILIA

Tuesday, November 22 is the Memorial of St. Cecilia, Virgin Martyr. Because she is the patron saint of music and musicians, there will be a Solemn Mass at 6 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola Cantorum will sing *Missa choralis* (Missa Orbis factor), Op. 102 by Vinzenz Goller; *Afferentur regi virgines* by Anton Bruckner; and *Cantantibus organis* by Philippe Rogier.

ADULT FAITH FORMATION MYSTAGOGY: CATHOLICISM FROM SOUP TO NUTS

Join Fr. Francis Belanger, O.P. on **Mondays through November 28**, at 7 PM, in St. Vincent Ferrer Parish Center. The class will meet Mondays during November, stop for December, then resume after the New Year.

All parishioners are welcome. The word "mystagogy" literally refers to the last stage of faith formation for converts. But, in another way, it is the life-long process by which fully initiated Catholics re-discover the faith and delve more deeply into the call of Christian discipleship. Feel like you missed some of the basic teachings? Aren't sure how to respond when your non-Catholic friends ask about your beliefs? Want to go past a high school understanding of your faith? This is for you!

Music Notes

Next Sunday, for the First Sunday of Advent, the Schola will sing music by Germanic Renaissance composers. Hans Leo Hassler, born in Nuremberg, was the son of an organist and received his first training from his father. In 1584, Hassler became the first of many German composers of the period to study in Venice where he befriended Giovanni Gabrieli and studied with his uncle, Andrea Gabrieli. He returned to Germany late in 1585 where he worked as a composer and an organist, briefly in Augsburg for the Fugger family. His final appointment was in Dresden as Kapellmeister to the Elector Christian II of Saxony, succeeded by Michael Praetorious and Heinrich Schütz. Although a Protestant, much of Hassler's music, including the Cantiones sacrae book of motets and a book of Masses, was written for the Roman liturgy.







ADVENT WREATH

Again this year we will place the Advent Wreath around the base of the Statue of the Blessed Mary, Porta Caeli, to the right of the Crossing Altar. Please contact the parish office, *parish@svsc.info*, or see Brother Damien about this opportunity for spiritual giving during the holy seasons of Advent and Christmas. Availability for Advent candle intentions would be as follows:

During these weeks, the Sanctuary Madonna lamp that usually hangs beside the Porta Caeli will not burn.

ADVENT

Sunday, November 27, is the First Sunday of Advent, which marks the beginning of the new liturgical year: Year A in the three-year lectionary cycle. The season of Advent (from the Latin *adventus* meaning "coming") looks forward to the birth of Christ, calling the faithful to prepare for his arrival: first in meekness and mercy and ultimately in judgment and glory.

Liturgies during this "privileged" season of Advent strike a note of anticipation and repentance that is mingled with joy and hope; hence, although penitential violet is the season's liturgical color, the *Gloria* is omitted, and the use of the organ is moderated, the *Alleluia* is retained.

The congregational Ordinary (*Kyrie*, *Sanctus*, and *Agnus Dei*) at Sung Masses changes to the Latin-version of *Missa XVIII*. The Marian Antiphon at the conclusion of Mass changes from *Salve Regina* (sung from Trinity Sunday until Advent) to *Alma Redemptoris Mater* (from Advent until Candlemas).

The Advent Wreath at both churches will be blessed at the Vigil Masses on November 26.


