#### **IMMACULATE CONCEPTION**

**Thursday, December 8** is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation and the Patronal Feast of the United States. There will be a Solemn Mass at 6 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola Cantorum will sing *Missa in G minor*, Op. 187; *Alma Redemptoris Mater*, Op. 171, No. 2; and *Ave maris stella*, Op. 171, No. 4 by Josef Rheinberger.

In addition to the regular weekday Mass and Confession schedule, there

will be a 1 PM Low Mass at St. Catherine of Siena.

The evening Masses on Wednesday, December 7 will be for the Vigil of the Solemnity and will satisfy the obligation.

The Act of Total Consecration to Jesus Christ through Mary will be made after Thursday's 5:15 PM Mass at St. Catherine of Siena.

#### MARIAN LESSONS AND CAROLS

On **Monday, December 12**, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, at 7 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer, there will be a Service of Lessons and Carols in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This hour-long celebration of the life of Mary will consist of a sequence of scripture readings, motets sung by the Schola Cantorum, and congregational hymns.

#### **MUSIC NOTES**

Next Sunday, for the Second Sunday of Advent, the Schola will sing music from the Italian Renaissance. Gregorio Allegri was a Roman Catholic priest, singer, and composer. After ordination, he was first stationed at the Cathedral of Fermo where he composed a large amount of sacred music that gained the approbation of Pope Urban VIII. He was *maestro di cappella* of the Church of Santo Spirito in Sassio, Rome before being appointed a singer in the Sistine Chapel choir in 1629. There he remained, eventually becoming *maestro* two years before his death. Although now almost exclusively known for his setting of Psalm 51, *Miserere mei, Deus*, his choral output in the Roman style of Palestrina is extensive, including two volumes of concerti for five voices, two volumes of motets, five Masses, two settings of the Lamentations of Jeremiah, and numerous motets.

As we continue our reflections on silence, may the Lord grant us graces to hear His voice stirring forth from His holy dwelling.


