MIDDAY RETREAT WITH THE MYSTICS: ST. BERNARD CLAIRVAUX

On Saturday, December 18, 12 NOON to 3 PM, at St. Catherine of Siena Church, we will continue our Midday Retreat with the Mystics (every 3rd Saturday of the month), this day focusing on St. Bernard of Clairvaux. St. Bernard (1090-1153) is a key figure in the unfolding of Christian spirituality, leaving his mark on the whole rest of our tradition. Fr. Ignatius John Schweitzer, O.P. will give a conference talk on St. Bernard, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and guided meditations from his writings. Come to hear how, according to St. Bernard, we can all "dare to aspire to mystical marriage with the Word" (Serm. 83), and to enter more deeply into the love of God. GAUDETE SUNDAY

The Third Sunday of Advent is the half-way point in the season and is known as Gaudete Sunday. This Latin title is taken from the incipit (first phrase) of the Introit of the Mass, *Gaudete in Domino semper* (Rejoice in the Lord always) quoting Philippians 4:4. As a reprieve from the penitential violet, the traditional liturgical color for the Third Sunday of Advent is rose. The analogous Sunday in Lent is the Fourth Sunday, called "Laetare."

MUSIC NOTES

Next weekend, for the Fourth Sunday of Advent, the Schola will sing a very brief setting of the Ordinary bearing the name of the Introit of Advent IV. Haydn was an Austrian composer, who along with Mozart and Schubert, epitomized the Austro-German style of the Classical period. Prodigious in output even by his contemporary standard, Haydn wrote 107 symphonies, 83 string quartets, 45 piano trios, 62 piano sonatas, 14 Masses, and 26 operas, as well as numerous smaller works.

Advent Novena – December 17 - 24

So many of us are caught up with hosts of pre-Christmas activities: from writing and mailing Christmas cards on a timely basis, preparing gift lists, shopping and wrapping the gifts, decorating the house inside and out, preparing of special holiday sweets, Christmas meals for family and friends during the holidays, and a multiple of other activities at church and in the neighborhood. Have I forgotten anything? Does it not all sound very familiar?

As we begin our new Liturgical Year with the Advent season, we are provided with the opportunity to stand quietly with the Prophet Isaiah as he shares the Word of God with us. It is not new, but we must listen as though it were for the first time. The prophet calls us to conversion as we prepare for the coming feast of the Incarnation of the Word Made Flesh.

We will, once again, explore the coming of the Lord, His Birth, His life and teachings, His Passion, Death and Resurrection and call to mind His promise to return "to take you with me, that where I am you also may be." What this season of Advent gives us is a chance to start over on that journey, to renew ourselves and once again, make ourselves ready. We do this through preparation for Christmas. The celebration of Christmas, the feast of the Incarnation, is not a celebration of what has already happened, it is a rehearsal for the day when Christ will come again.

Christmas allows us to dream. If we cannot dream, there is nothing to look forward to. Children dream of Santa, of a life filled with candy and toys, magic and lots of fun. Should not we, as adults, also be able to dream? Otherwise there is no meaning to life. Dickens wrote "Men open their shut-up hearts freely." And this is what we must allow ourselves to do, freely and joyfully, as we prepare for Christmas, the feast of the Incarnation of the Son of

God, the Word Made Flesh come to dwell in our midst.

Our Advent novena is offered on behalf of our most vulnerable of society, our children. Beginning on December 17 and concluding on Christmas Eve, we will pray in common, for the safety and wellbeing of children. This includes every child from conception, the cradle, the playpen, the classroom, and the playground. And during these difficult times we need to remember all children in broken homes, broken by reason of marriages and addictions, as well as those children in refugee camps.

The Novena Prayers will be said at each Mass celebrated in the two churches of the Parish. In addition to our

regular Mass schedule, we will celebrate the 'Misa de Gallo' at 6 AM at Saint Vincent Ferrer.

I invite you to participate with us at one of the daily Masses as well as placing your intentions for the Novena in one of the intention books. These books will be located on the Rosary Altar in the Church of St. Vincent Ferrer and on the Shrine Altar of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the church of St. Catherine of Siena. Novena Prayer cards will be made available for your use at these locations as well. May we pray together during these days immediately before Christmas that the joy and peace of the Holiday Season may be with all of us. Merry Christmas and a Blessed New Year.


