Parish Study A CHRISTMAS LITANY: THE SAINTS OF ADVENT AND YULETIDE

Tuesdays from December 6 through December 20 at 6:45 PM, in the Lower Church at St. Vincent Ferrer, Fr. Francis Belanger, O.P. will discuss how seasonal saints link such themes as apostleship, generosity, and ecumenism to the Birth of the Lord. Christmas Day is so powerful a celebration that it draws in the surrounding saints' celebrations and lends them an Advent and Christmas flavoring. Just as the "spirit of the season" affects our lives on more than just Christmas Day, so the memory and celebration of such saints days as St. Nicholas (December 6), St. Lucy (December 13), and St. Stephen (December 26), are suffused with joy and incarnation. On **Monday, December 12**, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, at 7 pm at St. Vincent Ferrer, there will be a Service of Lessons and Carols in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. RECONCILIATION MONDAY

Monday, December 19 is Reconciliation Monday throughout the entire Archdiocese of New York and the Diocese of Brooklyn, an opportunity for all to make their confession before Christmas. Confessions will be heard at St. Vincent Ferrer and St. Catherine of Siena (and are supposed to be heard similarly in all parishes) from 2–4 PM and from 6–8 PM.

Music Notes

Next Sunday, for the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete), the Schola will sing music a double motet by Palestrina. The Mass Ordinary by Duarte Lôbo uses the musical themes from this motet as its framework. The works of Lôbo, along with those of Manuel Cardoso, represent the golden age of Portuguese polyphony, roughly corresponding to the period of Spanish rule (1580-1640). A pupil of Manuel Mendes of Évora Cathedral, Lôbo was later appointed *mestre de capela* there. He subsequently served at Lisbon's Hospital Real before becoming *mestre* of Lisbon's Cathedral in 1594.

A Light Shining in the Darkness – Lessons and Carols

A faint light flickers from the Advent Candles in both of our churches. Week by week, we'll light another candle as we draw closer to the Nativity of the Lord. As the darkness increases around us daily, these candles become visible signs of the graces of the Lord shining through the darkness of sin and leading us to the ultimate light, that of the glory of the Lord in heaven. With these candles situated at the feet of the statue of Our Lady, the *Porta Cali*, at St. Vincent Ferrer, we are also reminded how the Virgin Mary guides us not only to welcome the Lord this Christmas but also through the whole of life so that we might be ready when He calls us through the gates of heaven to Himself at the end of our lives.


For those new to the parish or those who have not attended our Marian Lessons and Carols before, it is a beautiful service that encompasses the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In it, we encounter her example of holiness in the various mysteries of her life, and we see her virtues shining forth like candles softly illuminating a darkened church.


This year, we have moved this Lessons and Carols to the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, December 12. Previously, it had been on the Vigil of the Immaculate Conception, December 7. Yet, with a desire to not have two of our events compete with each other, namely this Lessons and Carols as well as the Solemn Mass on the night of the Immaculate Conception, we thought it would be fitting to move Lessons and Carols to the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. On that feast, we remember the beautiful gift of faith that Our Lady of Guadalupe brought to Mexico and to the entire American continent. Her loving embrace of the American peoples was a light shining in the darkness that both drove out the sin of child sacrifice and also led millions to quickly embrace her Son, Jesus Christ, as Lord. In the same way, may Our Lady of Guadalupe be instrumental in driving out the darkness of sin in our lives so that we may fully embrace the Light of Christ in all things.

On a similar note and after much reflection, we are going to move the Advent Lessons and Carols that had usually been on the Third Sunday of Advent at St. Catherine's to the Third Sunday of Easter. It was a beautiful service that allowed for deep prayer, but I want to make this adaptation for two reasons. First, I would like to avoid two competing events every year, such as the two Lessons and Carols services seemed to be. Secondly, no one else in the city does a sort of Marian Lessons and Carols in Easter. To have that at St. Catherine's would provide for a spiritual need that is currently not being met anywhere in the city of which I'm aware. Through it, may the Lord bear great fruit in our hearts so that the graces of the Easter Season will sink deeply within us and conform us more closely to Christ our Lord.

ADVENT WREATH




The First Week of Advent	1 candle
