CELEBRATIONS OF ST. DOMINIC

Our Holy Father Dominic, the founder of the Order of Preachers, died on August 6, 1221. To mark the 801st Anniversary, the Parish will have several days worth of special celebrations.

On Thursday, August 4, the traditional feastday of St. Dominic, there will be a Mass in the Dominican Rite at 7 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola Cantorum will sing Missa de Beata Maria by Tomás Luis de Victoria.

Monday, August 8 is the Solemnity of St. Dominic according to the modern liturgical calendar. There will be a Solemn Mass at 6 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola will sing Missa Brevis by Grayston Ives; Haec dies by Charles Wood; and Salve Regina, Op. 9, No. 4 by Herbert Howells, all music of 20th century Britain.

From August 2–8, the Memorial of Bl. Jane Aza, the mother of St. Dominic, to the Solemnity of St. Dominic, relics of St. Dominic will be displayed for veneration by the Rosary Altar at St. Vincent Ferrer.

MUSIC NOTES

Next Sunday, for the Eighteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Schola will sing music of two English recusant Catholics. Richard Deering, born in Hampshire, had by 1610 graduated from Christ Church, Oxford with a music degree. He traveled to Italy in the 1610s where he converted to Catholicism. By 1617, he was living in Brussels, employed as the organist of an English Benedictine community of nuns. He returned to England in 1625 as organist to the Catholic Queen Henrietta Maria and 'musician for the lutes and voices' to King Charles I. Much of his music has an Italian influence, especially that of the madrigal style.


