MUSIC NOTES

Next Sunday, for the Fifteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Schola will sing music for lower voices (tenor and bass). Likely born in Verona, Giommateo Asola began his studies with the Congregation of Secular Canons of St. George in Alga in Venice in 1546, after which he likely studied with Vincenzo Ruffo in Verona. Ordained a priest in 1569 and was appointed to the diocesan Church of St. Maria in Organo, Verona, in 1571. In 1577 he was named *maestro di cappella* at Treviso Cathedral but a year later moved to the Cathedral of Vicenza. He relocated to Venice in 1582 and in 1588 was appointed one of four chaplains of the Church of St. Severo. Apart from a brief return to Verona in 1590-1591, he remained at St. Serevo until his death.

CANDLE INTENTIONS

At St. Vincent Ferrer we have added seven additional opportunities for you to offer prayer intentions through the lighting of candles. Beautiful new candles have been added to the Rosary Altar, Our Lady of Fatima Shrine, St. Joseph's Chapel, Our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine, St. Patrick's Chapel, St. Martin de Porres Shrine, and the Holy Name Chapel. Candle intentions are still available in one or more of the seven hanging sanctuary lamps before the High Altar, the lamp beside Our Lady Gate of Heaven (Madonna Candle), and the lamp by the Pieta Statue.

The candles may be reserved in the Parish Office the same way you obtain a Mass intention. The candles will be lit on Friday for a period of one week. The weekly offering is \$20 and the intention will be announced in the bulletin.


