Conclusion of the 125th Anniversary Year of the Dominicans' Ministry at St. Catherine's

Come join us for the end of the 125th anniversary year celebrating the Dominican Friars' ministry at St. Catherine's on **Tuesday, August 29**. His Eminence Timothy Cardinal Dolan will be the main celebrant and preacher of the 5:15 PM Mass, and following the Mass, there will be a light reception in St. Joseph Hall.

This Mass will also commemorate the Memorial of the Passion of St. John the Baptist. The Schola will sing *Kleine Messe in F* by Josef Friedrich Doppelbauer; *Misso Herodes spiculatore* by Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina; and *In dedicatione temple* by Andrea Rota.

John the Baptist has two feast days in the liturgical calendar: one commemorating his birth (June 24th) and the other his death by beheading (August 29th). His passion is frequently depicted in art, notably Richard Strauss' opera *Salome*, Op. 54.

The candles may be reserved in the Parish Office the same way you obtain a Mass intention. The candles will be lit on Friday for a period of one week. The weekly offering is \$20 and the intention will be announced in the bulletin. A card is available upon request.


