### PARISH OUTREACH

As New York City and the Archdiocese of New York continue to reopen our parish has resumed in-person Masses following the regulations of the Archdiocese. The regulations allow us to have gatherings in church at 25% capacity. Since it is summer, and since many have left the city, we think we will be safe having our **regular schedule of Masses** with proper precautions observed. Likewise, **regular confessions** can now be heard as usual, provided we maintain social distance in the confession line.

For Masses we will need to observe the following:

- We need to wear a mask, or its equivalent, in church.
- We practice social distancing as indicated by the markers.
- We make frequent use of the hand sanitizer provided.
- The churches will be cleaned between masses.
- Please follow instructions for the distribution of Holy Communion that will be given at the Mass.

### Passion of St. John the Baptist

Saturday, August 29 is the Memorial of the Passion of St. John the Baptist. There will be a Sung Mass at 9 AM at St. Catherine of Siena.

John the Baptist has two feast days in the liturgical calendar: one commemorating his birth (June 24) and the other his death by beheading (August 29). His passion is frequently depicted in art, notably Richard Strauss' opera *Salome*, Op. 54.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Dear Families,

As we prepare for a new year of Religious Education at St. Vincent Ferrer and St. Catherine of Siena Parish, we recognize that this year will be unique and challenging for all of you. We are committed to providing quality faith formation and spiritual support for your children during this time, while also working to protect everyone's health and safety. Our goal is to serve our parish families in the most effective ways possible to meet your particular needs.

For the 2020-2021 academic year, we will offer both on-site and remote learning opportunities for your children. Our in-person sessions will be adapted to meet Archdiocesan safety protocols. The following modifications will be in effect for the upcoming year, but may be revised at any time as the situation develops:

- The first day of sessions will be **Monday, October 5, 2020** to allow some extra time for your children to adjust to their new school situations.
- In-person sessions will be limited to 5 children per session at St. Catherine of Siena and 3 children per session at St. Vincent Ferrer to maintain social distancing.
- In-person sessions have been shortened to **one hour each** to allow for more options since we must limit the number of children per session.
- There will be a 30-minute break between sessions to allow for cleaning and for all children to leave before the next group arrives for screening. It will be imperative that children be dropped off and picked up on time.
- The Atrium or classroom will be **cleaned and disinfected** between each session.
- Parents and caregivers will drop off and pick up children at St. Catherine's from the rear of the church where they can social distance, instead of from the vestibule outside the Atrium.
- We will **check each catechist's and each child's temperature using a touchless thermometer** before they enter the Atrium or classroom. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° F or above will not be permitted to enter.
- Parents, caregivers, and middle school children who arrive unaccompanied must satisfactorily answer four **health-screening questions** before the children will be permitted to enter.
- Adults and children will wear masks during in-person sessions.
- Adults and children will use **hand sanitizer** before entering the Atrium or classroom.
- We will provide a **plastic safety shield** for each child's work area in the Atrium.
- There will be **no eating** in the Atrium or classroom. Please ensure your child has a snack before coming to Religious Education.
- If a child begins to exhibit symptoms of illness during a session, we will call a parent or caregiver to pick them up.
- In case of any known exposure to COVID, sessions will be conducted via Zoom at the regular class time until it is safe to resume in-person meetings.
- All sessions will be held over Zoom for the first two sessions after the Christmas Break to allow catechists and children to quarantine following any holiday travel.
- Any children who normally attend an in-person session and travel at other times should join their appropriate Zoom session, rather than attending in person, for two weeks upon their return to NYC.
- If New York City returns to stay-at-home orders at any point during the academic year, all sessions will be held via Zoom at their regularly scheduled day and time.
