EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS-OUR LADY OF SORROWS

Tuesday, September 14 is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. There will be a Solemn Mass at 5:15 PM at St. Catherine of Siena. The Schola Cantorum will sing Josef Rheinberger's Messe in G, Op. 151, 'Sanctae crucis', and Orlando di Lasso's O crux splendidior - Dulce lignum.

Wednesday, September 15 is the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows. There

will be a Sung Mass at 5:15 PM at St. Catherine of Siena.

There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Catherine of Siena on Tuesday and Wednesday following the 7 AM Mass and concluding with Benediction and the recitation of the Rosary before the 5:15 PM Mass.

One of two such periods of extended adoration offered annually in the Parish, this one is offered for the intentions for those suffering in the hospitals and for those who care for them. The other, at St. Vincent Ferrer, marks the end of the liturgical year on the Solemnity of Christ the King.

MASS CELEBRATING ST. MARGARET OF CASTELLO, O.P.

On Saturday, September 18 there will be a Sung Mass at 12 NOON at St. Catherine of Siena to celebrate the canonization of St. Margaret of Castello, a 14th century Dominican tertiary who was born a crippled, blind, and hunchbacked dwarf. Through her holy life she is now a patroness of the disabled. Fr. Jonah Pollock, o.p., Executive Director of the Dominican Friars Healthcare Ministry of New York, will be the celebrant, and Fr. Joseph Allen, O.P., will be the homilist. A holy card of St. Margaret will be distributed at Mass.

OCTAVE OF PRAYER

SOLEMN MASS FOR OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM

There will be a Solemn Mass for the Blessed Virgin Mary on Friday, September 24 at 7 PM at St. Vincent Ferrer. This Mass will be celebrated according to the Anglican Ordinariate Use of the Roman Rite and will be the first such Mass ever offered in New York City. All are most welcome.

The Personal Ordinariate was created by Pope Benedict XVI in 2009; it allows groups of former Anglicans converting to Catholicism to retain some of their liturgical patrimony.

The Blessed Virgin Mary's apparition to Lady Richeldis de Faverches in 1061 in the small village of Walsingham in Norfolk inspired what would become the strongest Marian devotion of the Catholic faithful in England. A pilgrimage to Our Lady of Walsingham's shrine trailed only those to Rome and Santiago de Compostela in popularity. Destroyed in the Reformation in 1538, Pope Leo XIII re-founded the shrine in 1896, sparking a resurgence of devotion in the 20th century.

Fr. Armando Alejandro, Jr., a priest of the Ordinariate, will celebrate the Mass, and Fr. Bonaventure Chapman, O.P., himself a convert from Anglicanism, will preach.

The Parish's Schola Cantorum will sing music of the Anglican choral tradition, including Herbert Howells's *Collegium Regale Communion Service*, originally written for the choir of King's College, Cambridge.

YOUTH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Dear Families,

As we prepare for a new year of religious education at the Parish of St. Vincent Ferrer and St. Catherine of Siena, we recognize that we must still contend with the challenges of COVID-19. We are committed to providing quality faith formation and spiritual support for your children during this time, while also striving to protect everyone's health and safety. Our goal is to serve our parish families in the most effective ways possible to meet your particular needs.

Our Parish youth faith formation program serves children from three-years-old through eighth grade, as well as high school students who are not yet confirmed. For children aged 3 through sixth grade, we will offer Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS). There are CGS options available on Sundays, Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at St. Catherine of Siena. We will also offer Confirmation preparation for seventh and eighth graders (or high school students who are not yet confirmed) on Tuesdays at St. Vincent Ferrer.

For the 2021-2022 catechetical year, our religious education sessions will be in-person with adaptations to meet Archdiocesan COVID safety guidelines. The following protocols will be in effect for the upcoming year, but may be revised at any time as the situation continues to develop:

• The first day of sessions will be Sunday, September 19.

• In-person sessions will be limited to 10 children per session at St. Catherine of Siena and 7 children per session at St. Vincent Ferrer to maintain social distancing.

• There will be a break between sessions to allow for cleaning and for all children to leave before the next group arrives for screening. It is imperative that children be dropped off and picked up on time.

• The Atrium or classroom will be cleaned and disinfected between each session.

• Parents and caregivers will drop off and pick up children at St. Catherine's from the rear of the church where they can social distance, instead of from the vestibule outside the Atrium.

• We will check each catechist's and each child's temperature using a touchless thermometer before they enter the Atrium or classroom. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° F or above will not be permitted to enter.

• Parents, caregivers, and middle school children who arrive unaccompanied must satisfactorily answer four health-screening questions before the children will be permitted to enter.

 Our catechists are vaccinated, but all adults and children will continue to wear masks during in-person sessions.

• Adults and children will use hand sanitizer before entering the Atrium or classroom.

• There will be no eating in the Atrium or classroom. Please ensure your child has a snack before coming to religious education.

• If a child begins to exhibit symptoms of illness during a session, we will call a parent or caregiver to pick him or her up immediately.

• In case of any known exposure to COVID-19, sessions will be conducted via Zoom for the first half-hour of the regular class time until it is safe to resume in-person meetings.

HOLY MASS CELEBRATING THE CANONIZATION OF SAINT MARGARET OF CASTELLO

Pope Francis canonized Saint Margaret of Castello on April 24, 2021, but the solemn Eucharistic celebration of her canonization will take place on September 19, 2021, in Citta di Castello, Italy, where Saint Margaret's body lies incorrupt at Saint Dominic Church. Our celebration of Saint Margaret's canonization at Saint Catherine Church in New York City will take place that same weekend.

Margaret of Castello, blind and crippled from birth, was imprisoned by her parents then abandoned in an unknown city and left to fend for herself. But her undaunted faith in God, cheerful love for all, compassion for the suffering of others, and heroic – sometimes miraculous – works of mercy, caused her to be celebrated for her sanctity and recognized as a heavenly patron of the poor and disabled.
