FALL PARISH STUDY

Join us for a Parish Study on the Sermon on the Mount on Tuesdays, from **September 27 to October 25** at 6:45 PM in the Lower Church at St. Vincent Ferrer, Fr. Albert Paretsky, O.P. will provide a close reading of the Sermon on the Mount and show how the spiritual path presented runs throughout the Gospel of Matthew.

The study will explore how the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew chapters 5-7) has been called a handbook for preparing the believer for the life of the Kingdom, a sermon on the ethical demands that the Kingdom makes on the present, or a blueprint for re-ordering social structures here and now. It is all of these and more. In this course, Fr. Albert will speak about how Jesus bases His preaching on the order of God's moral universe, and how this spiritual path is present throughout the entire Gospel of Matthew: "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well" (Mt. 6:33).

ROSARY SUNDAY CONFIRMATIONS

Next **Sunday, October 2**, at the 9:30 AM Mass at St. Vincent Ferrer, the Most Reverend Gerald T. Walsh, Auxiliary Bishop of New York, will offer the Sacrament of Confirmation to the catechumens from our Parish's Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program.

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

Friday, October 7 is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, and we have designated it as the principal Marian Feast of the Parish. As such, there will be a **Solemn Mass and Procession at 6** PM at St. Vincent Ferrer for which the Schola Cantorum will sing *Missa Salve Regina* by Tomás Luis de Victoria; *Ave Maria* by Pedro de Cristo; and *Ego flos campi* by Juan Gutiérrez de Padilla. Following the Mass, a relic of Our Lady's veil will be available for veneration.

October is dedicated as the month of the Holy Rosary. On October 7, 1571, the heavily-outnumbered navy of the Holy League, organized by Pope Pius V (a Dominican) and composed of forces from the major Catholic maritime states in the Mediterranean—primarily the Venetian Republic and the Spanish Empire—defeated the Turkish fleet in a battle off Lepanto on the coast of Greece. Because the victory was attributed to the recitation of the Rosary, the Pope instituted October 7 as a day honoring Mary under the title "Our Lady of Victory." The universal feast, known as that of Our Lady of the Rosary, is particularly important to the Order of Preachers.

WEEKLY DOMINICAN RITE MASS

In light of requests from parishioners, we will begin having a weekly Low Mass in the Dominican Rite (Latin) on Saturdays at 9:30am at the Rosary Altar at St. Vincent's. This will begin on October 22.

MUSIC NOTES

Next Sunday, the Twenty-seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time, as the first Sunday in October, the Parish will celebrate Rosary Sunday, anticipating the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on Friday, October 7. The Schola will sing two Marian motets by Giovanni Francesco Anerio. He was an Italian composer of the Roman School, bridging the late Renaissance and early Baroque periods. (His elder brother Felice was also a composer.) Giovanni Francesco is credited with one of the earliest extent oratorios. His musical style is more progressive then other Roman composers, though he also shared some of the stylistic tendencies of his brother who was much indebted to Palestrina. He served for several years as *maestro di cappella* of the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran in Rome (like Palestrina and Lasso) and later held a similar post at the Verona Cathedral. He became a priest in 1616, and in 1624 became choirmaster to King Sigismund III of Poland in Warsaw.




