FOR THE PARENTS

In preparation for the pre-baptism meeting with the priest, please watch the four videos below (an hour total) from the "Reborn" series on the FORMED.org platform and come ready to discuss them. FOR THE GODPARENTS

To help the godparents prepare for the baptism, please forward the other document "Baptism Prep for Godparents" to the godparents you have chosen. They too should prepare themselves for this beautiful and important responsibility. This will help them be ready for the sacrament, their role in it, and the ways that they can continue to support the spiritual growth of their godchild throughout the whole of his or her life.

Finally, please have each of the godparents get a letter of suitability from their local pastor (we have a sample letter that can be given to help facilitate this, which is in the same document.) These letters should be returned to the priest celebrating the baptism at least three weeks in advance.
